
### Past Week Accomplishments (Team):

  - These 10 sites provided by John share a lot of similarities in terms of the site layout


## Pending issues:

#### Individual work:

• Piper Ideker, February 25th: We had a team meeting on how to connect flywheel to local, and assigned two websites to start working on. I successfully connected one of the websites I chose, but I had a problem when I started to work with it on WordPress. We

can work with a plug-in called Elementor, and he gave us a license that we can use so we can work with it for free. Unfortunately, we have to upgrade our WordPress accounts in order to even download the plug-ins and only then can we use the plug-ins. After that, I figured that I can at least link the 2 websites so I'll be ready to go once the issue is resolved, but there was another problem. Originally, John gave us all the information we needed, but replaced the website with something that he thought would be easier to work with. He updated the list of websites document, but didn't give us the zip file or the flywheel invitation to connect it to local, so for right now I'm stuck. I still had the original website names, so I took a look at each of them and I started to break down the Aunebrothers homepage with a to-do list for when I get access to work on them.


#### Danh Hoang, February 25th:

  - We split up the sites so that there wouldn't be issues when we are pushing the updates


## Bryant David, February 25th:

- In our last meeting with John on the 23rd of February, a lot of pending issues were resolved like, the logins, user collaboration access, sites to work on right away etc.
  - I have tagged my name to a couple of sites: Cherrybuildinggroup.com and Chestnuthilldev.com
- Piper Ideker, February 26th: I found out how to connect Elementor to WordPress, and it solved the \$25 a month issue. I also found the zipfile and I had access to work on the Aunebrothers website, so I started with the header. I got the navigation bar and the "Call Us Today" button, but there's still some issues. First, elementor doesn't like any image that I upload, and says that it won't use the images because of security reasons. I tried messing with the wp-config file to override this, but it didn't do anything. Second, in the website when you click the "Call Us Today" button, the text turns into the phone number and then back to the original text when clicked again. So far the only thing elementor can do is take you to an external link, so I need to do more research for that. Finally, I'm having trouble actually connecting the header to the WordPress site.
