

I accidentally put in the original website's link instead of linking to my WordPress page that I created. For example in Figure 2a, that Learn More button is supposed to go to the Services page that I made, not the website I'm basing it on. There were some links to pages that haven't been created, and for those I left the links for now and I created a note of the ones I haven't changed.
