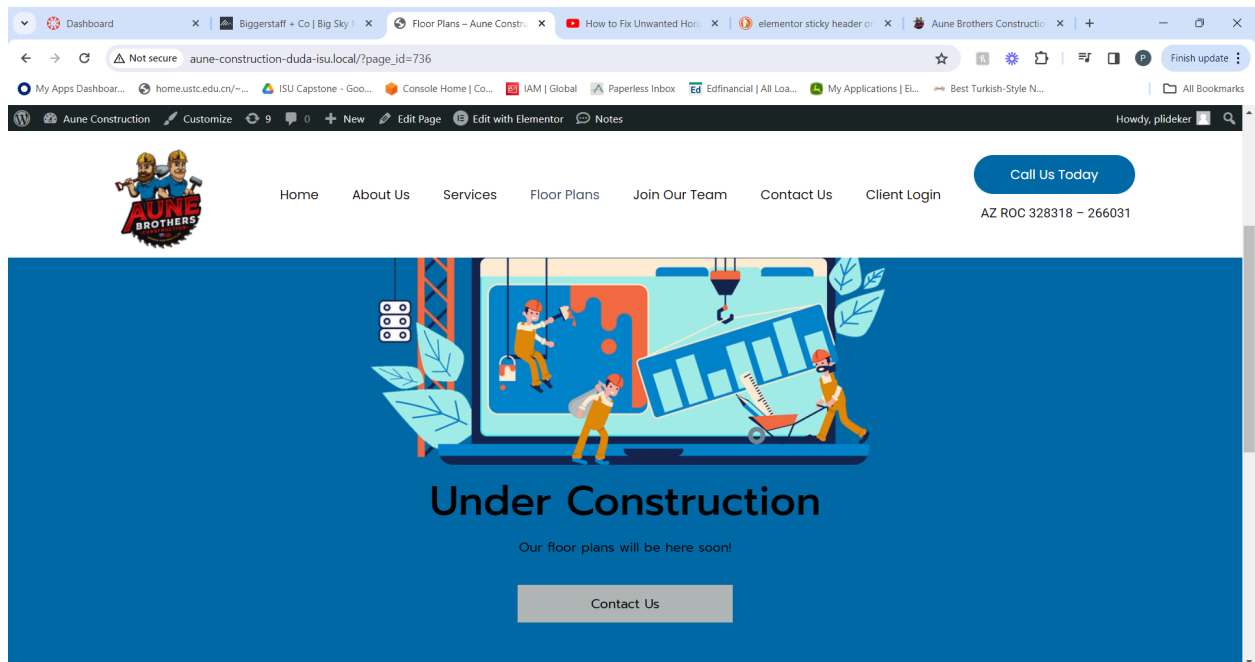


Figure 1, Floor Plan Page

New header:

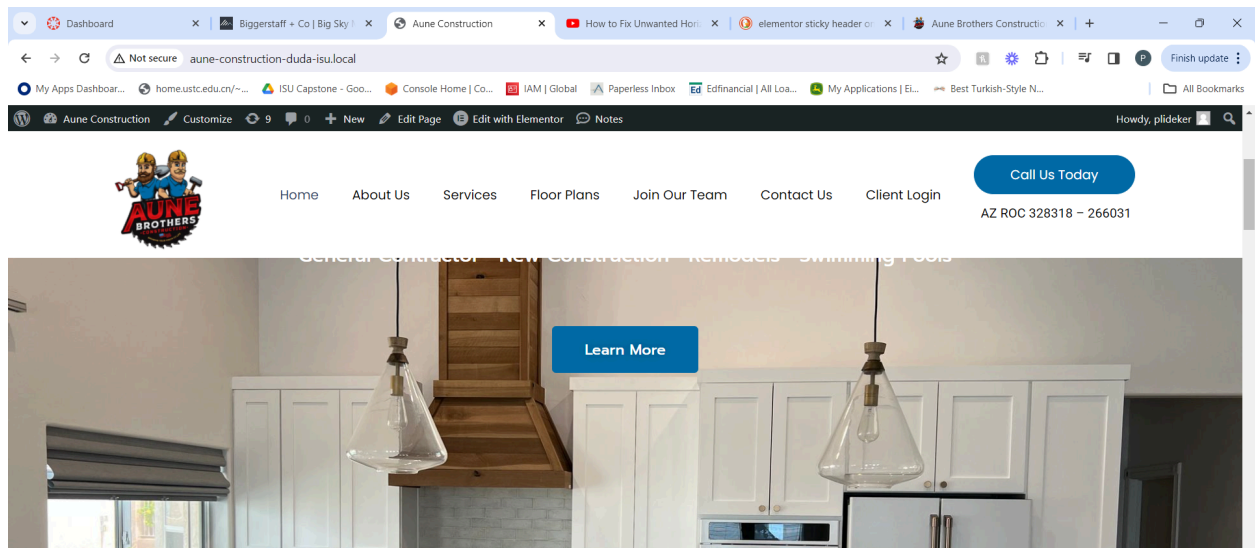


Figure 2, "Sticky" Header

Two icon buttons:

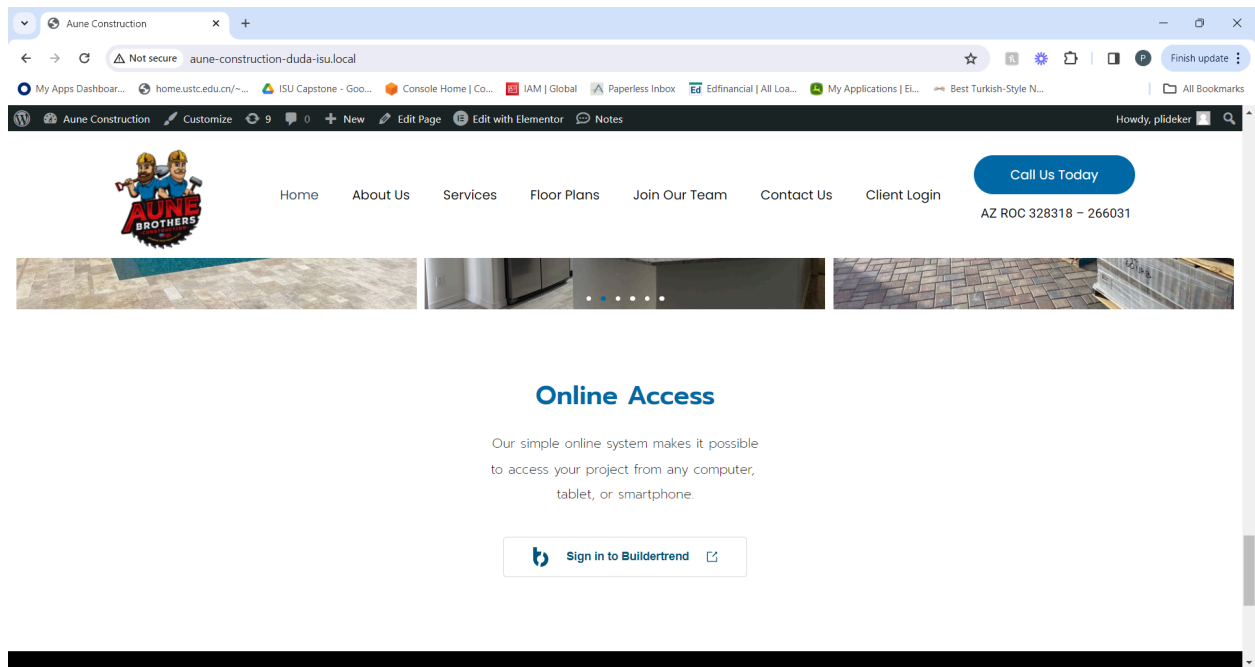

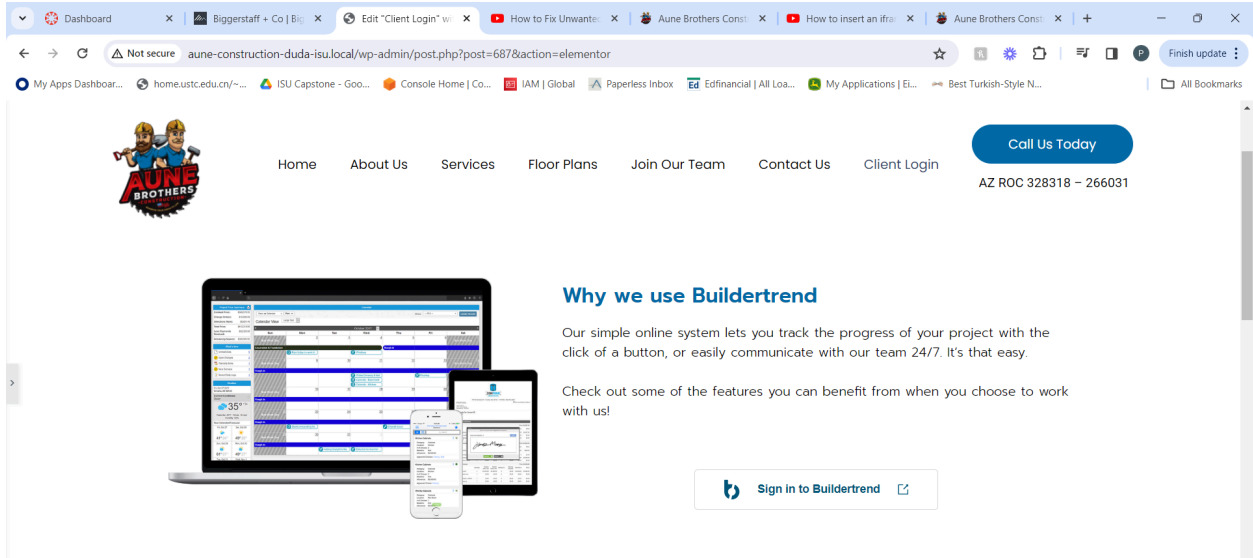

New Contact Us page:

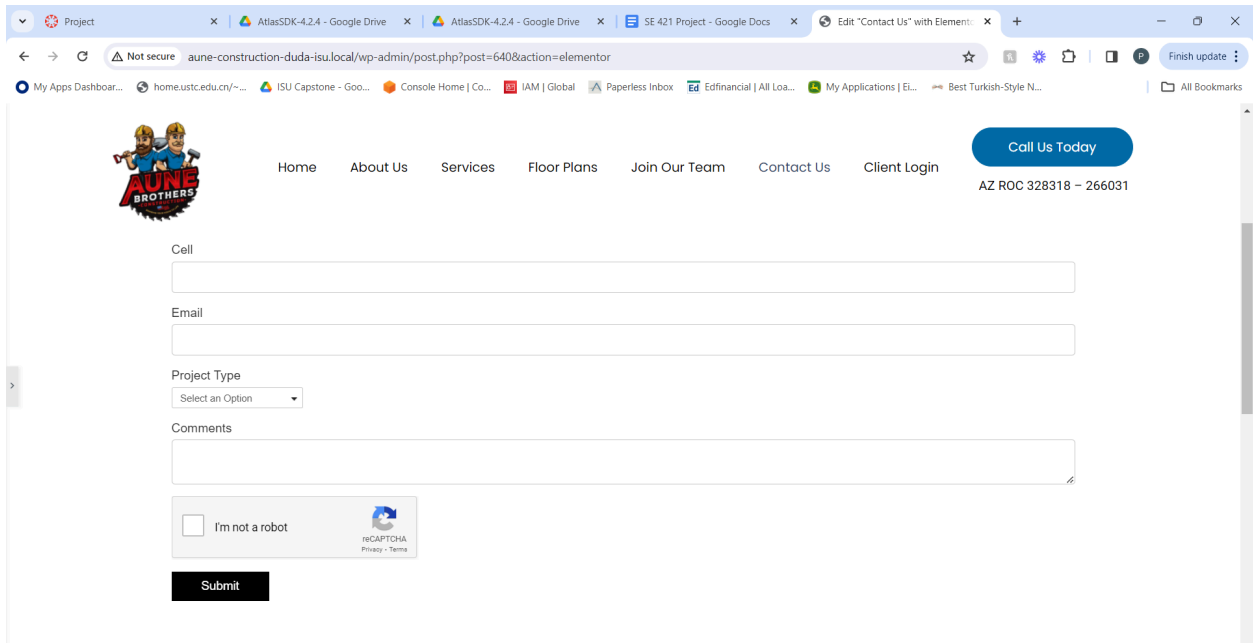

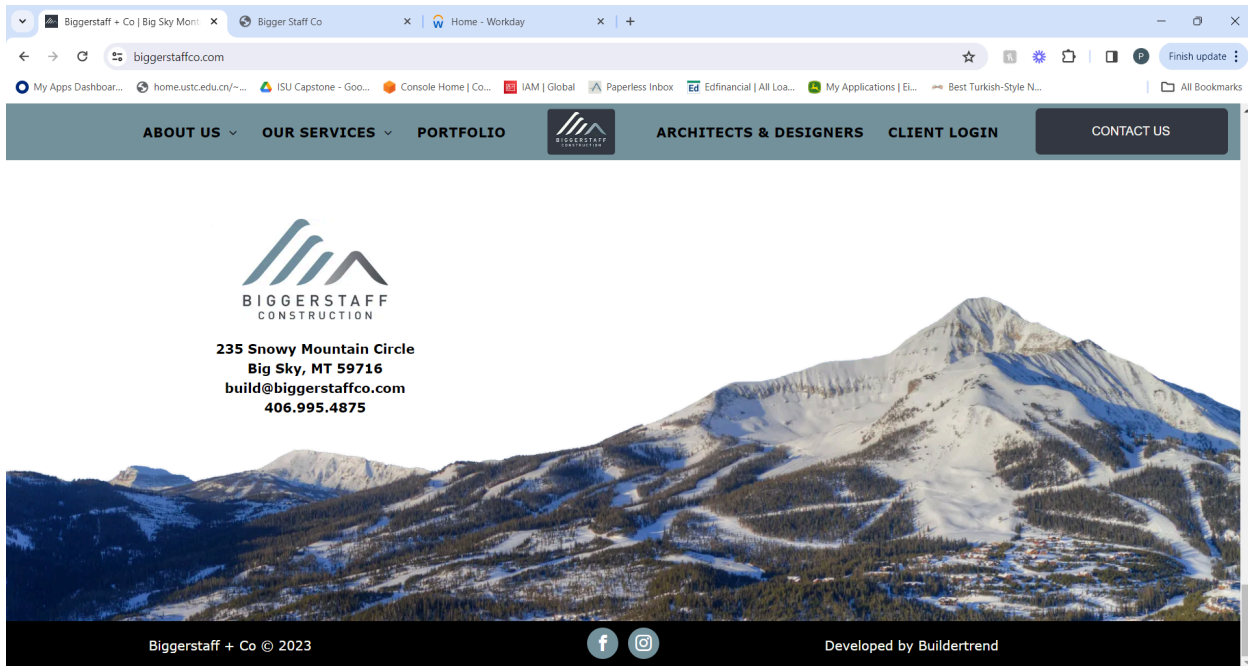

My Version:

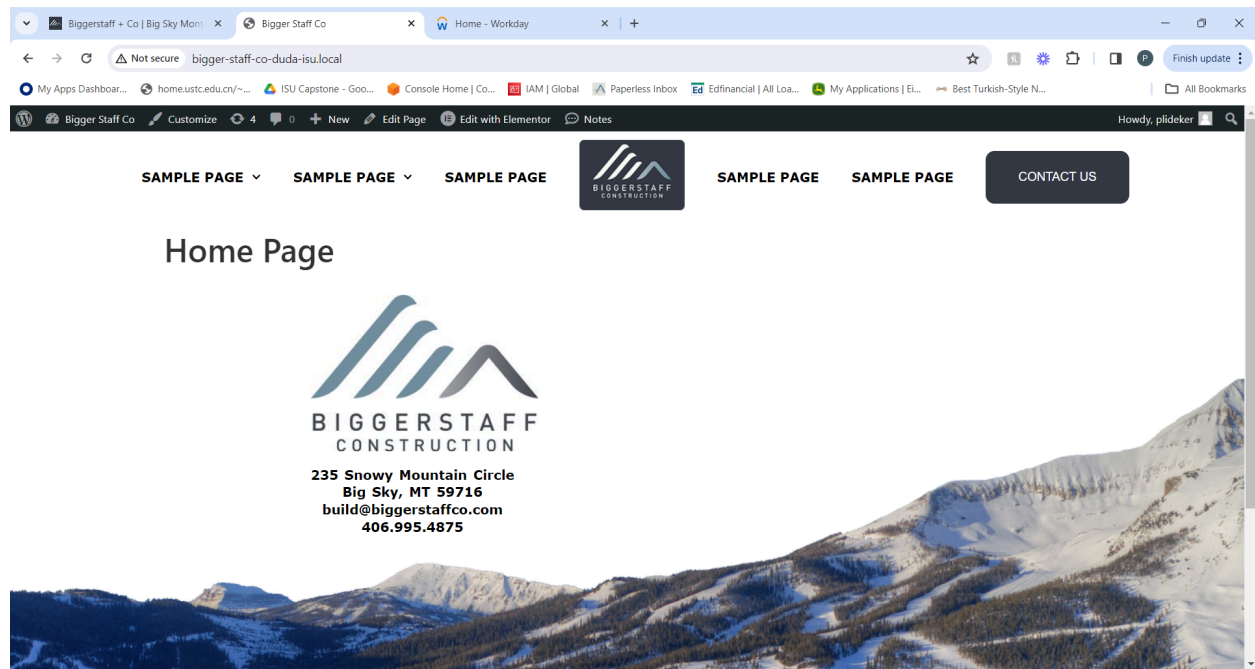
